These services are available not only to high school students (In-School Youth), but also to Out-of-School Youth who 1) have dropped out of school and are interested in furthering their education and preparing for the workforce, or 2) have earned a high school diploma or GED, but are unemployed, underemployed or deficient in basic skills.
